

Job Opening: Maintenance Worker I

Provo City Housing Authority is seeking applications from a career-oriented, highly motivated, self-starter for a full-time **Maintenance Worker I Position. This position will be primarily performing grounds and landscaping maintenance and repair.**

Qualified candidates should possess a high school diploma and a minimum of 2 years experience performing the following skills: knowledge and experience in installation, maintenance, and repair of sprinkler systems, installation and maintenance of landscaping materials, spraying lawn chemicals, and use of maintenance power lawn equipment. Other duties include plumbing, electrical, and HVAC repair and maintenance, drywall repair and painting, and other routine maintenance activities as assigned. Individual should have good customer service and communication skills. Individual will be on-call for maintenance emergencies one week per month. Individual must take and pass the Utah Applicator's Exam within one year.
